Title: Need to provide suitable compensation to the bereaved families of brave police personnels who laid down their lives while battling militants at Norat Jaimal Singh area, Bhamial in Punjab-laid.

SHRI PRATAP SINGH BAJWA (GURDASPUR): I wish to draw the attention of the Hon'ble Home Minister to the recent encounter that took place at Narat Jaimal Singh area, Bhamial wherein two militants who crossed over from Pakistan were killed. In the process two police personnel, namely, Shri Narinder Singh and Shri Sawinder Singh scarified their lives for our motherland. These great sons of India who lost their lives while discharging their duties near the India-Pakistan border at Gurdaspur, which is my constituency deserve not only a meritorious recognition, but also their families have to be taken care of. It has been brought to my notice that the families of these great sons of India are at a loss not knowing as to how to take care of the future of their children and their very survival is in question.
