Title: Need to ban the production and use of Endosulfan, a pesticide affecting human health in the country.

It is being used in India by other plantation growers also. Endosulfan contaminates air, water, plants and speedily spreads to other places. I request the Government to take immediate measures to ban the production and use of Endosulfan in the country. I also request the Government to extend help to those people who are the victims of Endosulfan, especially in Kerala in the Kasargod district. .
