Title : Need to declare Alampoor, a pilgrimage centre in Mahabubnagar district, Andhra Pradesh as a tourist centre and provide necessary infrastructure for tourists.

DR. MANDA JAGANNATH (NAGARKURNOOL): Alampoor in Mehbubnagar district of Andhra Pradesh is world famous Pilgrimage Centre having the name of the one of the Shakthi Peethas of India. It is the abode of Mata Joghulamba alongwith Lord Bala Parameswara (Lord Shiva).

Lakhs of devotees visit Alampoor pilgrimage Centre annually but as it has not been given the status of a Tourist Centre and it is lacking basic amenities like facilities for stay, good drinking water etc. If the lodging facilities are improved, as this pilgrimage centre is situated on the Banks of River Thungabhadra, pilgrims will be staying overnight and this will also increase the revenue to the Alampoor Temple.

Alampoor could also be made good educational hub as the place is only 20 KMs away from NH-7 and has a beautiful location. Hence, through you Madam, I request the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India to declare Alampoor pilgrimage centre as one of the Tourist Centres and take necessary steps to provide infrastructure like guest houses and parks etc.
