Title : Need for modernization of Tiruppur Railway Station in Tamil Nadu.

SHRI C. SIVASAMI (TIRUPPUR): Tiruppur, my Parliamentary Constituency in Tamil Nadu is district headquarters and famous for garment exports, earning Rs. 11,000 crores in foreign exchange. Many foreigners are visiting this city. The condition of Tiruppur Railway Station is very pathetic and it lacks basic amenities. This railway station should be included in the modernization plan to cater to the needs of foreigners. To ease the traffic a new electric train between Palakad-Coimbatore-Tiruppur-Erode may be operated at least six times a day. Two new trains may be operated from Tiruppur to Chennai and from Tiruppur to Nagercoil via Erode, Madurai daily. Additional ticket booking counter, a separate reservation counter and five Railway over-bridges may also be provided at Tiruppur. In the recent railway budget, a new train has been announced between Shoranur to Coimbatore. The same may be extended to Tiruppur. I plead the Government to fulfill the needs of the people of Tiruppur.
