THOMAS): Madam Speaker, on behalf of Shri Sharad Pawar, I beg to lay the Statement on the status of implementation of recommendations contained in the Forty-Third Report of the Standing Committee on Agriculture in pursuance of the direction 73 A of the hon. Speaker, Lok Sabha, issued vide Lok Sabha Bulletin – Part II dated September 01, 2004.

The Standing Committee on Agriculture has examined the Demands for Grants of the Ministry of Agriculture, Department of Agricultural Research and Education (DARE) for the year 2008-09 and presented their Forty-Third Report based on the Action Taken by the Government on the Recommendations/Observations contained in the Thirth-Eighth Report of the Standing Committee on Agriculture (2008-09).
