title: Issue regarding racial attacks on Indians living overseas.

SHRI Y.V. SUBBA REDDY (ONGOLE): Madam, since January this year, the attacks on immigrants, particularly on Indians, are going on unabated. Some hon. Members had raised this issue earlier when three Indians were attacked recently.

Madam, I am bringing to your notice and also bringing to the notice of the Government as also the hon. Minister of External Affairs, Shrimati Sushma Swaraj Ji, a brazen incident which occurred in the US in which two Indians - wife of a software engineer and her six-year old son, Hanisih Sai - were killed last night in New Jersey. It is reported that while Narra Hanumanthu Rao was in office, his wife, Shrimati Sashikala and his son, Hanisih Sai, were attacked and killed. When Hanumanthu Rao returned his home, he noticed this terrible incident and he is still in shock. This is the pinnacle of racial discrimination being shown towards immigrants in the US after taking over by Mr. Trump.

The relatives of Mr. Rao are in terrible shock. They are from Prakasam district which is my native district. Mr. Rao belongs to Thimmarajupalem village from my district. We are still struggling to forget the tragic killing of Srinivas and one more Indian and a new dastardly act has come to light.

I strongly feel that now it is high time and we should not take this issue lightly. We have to make the US aware of India and Indians. Otherwise, these kinds of incidents would continue unabated.
