Title: Need to improve the condition of rural roads in Dibrugarh Parliamentary constituency of Assam through centrally sponsored schemes.

SHRI RAMESHWAR TELI (DIBRUGARH): Dibrugarh district located in the easter part of Assam having a population of about 13,26,335 is very famous for its tea gardens, flora and fauna and oil industries. Surrounded by almost 200 tea gardens, Dibrugarh town is one of the major towns in the North Eastern India. But unfortunately, the district of Dibrugarh does not have proper road connectivity. Its 1362 villages are still without motorable roads. The roads that lead to interior places are in dilapidated condition. In the absence of proper road connectivity, students, farmers, traders, workers all are facing a lot of problems. The situation worsens further during rainy season. Patients, particularly in the rural areas being worst sufferers, since at times it takes hours to reach hospitals.

I, therefore, urge upon the Government to take urgent step under various centrally sponsored schemes for improving the rural road infrastructure in my constituency Dibrugarh.
