Title: Need to send a central team to assess the crop-damage caused due to recent unseasonal rains in Karimganj parliamentary Constituency, Assam.

SHRI RADHESHYAM BISWAS (KARIMGANJ): Entire Parliament is in favour of providing compensation to the agriculturists. Agriculture is the major source of income for the people of my constituency, Karimganj, Assam. Due to recent unseasonal rains, 4000 hectares of agricultural land in Sonbill, 1500 hectares in Ratabill, 400 hectares in Tapang block area, 300 hectares in Chatla & 100 hectares in Bakrihawar, Boro, crop was submerged and got damaged totally. The local growers are now in a very miserable position both economically and mentally.
