Title: Need to set up a Kendriya Vidyalaya in Vullupuram in Tamil Nadu.

SHRI S. RAJENDRAN (VILLUPPURAM): Hon. Chairman, Sir, thank you very much for the opportunity given to me to represent the educational demands.

My constituency, Villuppuram, is the largest district in Tamil Nadu. It is one of the most backward districts in India. Villuppuram District consists of 12 revenue taluks, 22 panchayat unions, 1,490 revenue villages. The main occupation of the district is agriculture. Makkal Mudalvar Puratchi Thalaivi Amma had implemented 'Sakshar Bharat Scheme' in the year 2009 and is functioning well. Moreover, Amma is taking innovative and drastic steps to make Tamil Nadu a 100 per cent literate State in India.
