Title: Need to develop Koulas Fort in Nizamabad district of Telengana as a tourist spot.

SHRI BHEEMRAO B. PATIL (ZAHEERABAD): I would like to bring to your kind notice regarding the dire need to sanction financial assistance for the development of a massive Koulas Fort situated in Jukkal, Nizamabad District in Telangana State. The oval-shaped Fort is situated on the Sangareddy-Nanded highway on the border of Telangana, near to Bidar in Karnataka. The history of Koulas Fort dates back to the 15th century during the rule of the Kakatiya kings spread across six square kms. and tucked away in a corner of backward Nizamabad district. Constructed in the semi-Dravidian style, the Fort has the potential of becoming a much sought after tourist destination. Koulas dam is about 20 kms. away from the Fort and attracts a large number of migratory birds during winter season. River and thick forest cover give an "Amazon look" when viewed from the Fort...
