Title: Need to release additional funds for flood ravaged regions of Andhra Pradesh.

SHRI RAM MOHAN NAIDU KINJARAPU (SRIKAKULAM): The Rayalaseema region of Andhra Pradesh has been at the receiving end of incessant and unseasonal rainfall. Many parts of Kadappa, Chittor, Kurnool, Anantpur and Uttarandhra had received heavy rainfall and it has caused a great amount of inconvenience to the people. The rains had led to over flow of drains and all the major reservoirs were at the brink of overflow. The town of Tirupati was also immensely flooded which caused great inconvenience to the local population and the tourists. The state government handled the crisis and is in the process of rehabilitating the people affected in the floods. As you are aware, the rebuilding of the roads and the infrastructure is a long drawn process involving a great deal of expenditure. I would like to request the Government to help the state government in this regard by releasing additional funds on priority basis for the purpose.
