Title: Need to name the newly constructed railway station between Jogeshwari and Goregon as 'Ram Mandir Railway Station'.

SHRI GAJANAN KIRTIKAR (MUMBAI NORTH WEST): Madam Speaker, thank you for giving me this opportunity to make my 'Zero Hour' submission on naming the newly constructed railway station between Jogeshwari and Goregon that falls under my constituency on the western line as Ram Mandir Road Railway Station. That is my submission to the Minister of Railways.

This area comes under the jurisdiction of my parliamentary constituency. The construction of the said railway station is almost complete. There is a possibility that the said railway station would be operational in one or two months. In this connection, I want to emphasize that the area where the said railway station has been constructed is prominently known as Ram Mandir Road area since a long time. Therefore, I urge upon the hon. Railway Minister to name the newly constructed railway station as `Ram Mandir Railway Station', for which the people of that area would remain eternally grateful to the NDA Government.
