Title: Need to save Girl Child.

SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMCHANDRAN (VADAKARA): The census data has come out with the startling revelation that there is a clear birth advantage for male children in India. It is a well established fact that this male advantage is artificial at the exclusion of the female child. Female foeticide is still prevalent in some parts of India and pre natal sex determination is leading to more boys being born. India is a young nation and our demographic divide is laudable.
