Title: Need to declare Nabadwip as National Heritage city.

DR. TAPAS MANDAL (RANAGHAT): Sir, Nabadwip city of Nadia district, West Bengal is under my constituency, Ranaghat. It was a centre of learning and philosophy in medieval India and is still noted for its traditional Sanskrit schools. This great land is the birth place of the leader of the Bhakti movement, Chaitanya Mahaprabhu.

Nabadwip was also the capital of Bengal Empire under the regime of Ballal Sen and Lakshman Sen, the famous rulers of the Sen Empire.
