PROF. SAUGATA ROY (DUM DUM): Madam, I would be very brief. My submission is with regard to the State of Jammu and Kashmir. Another protestor succumbed to injuries in Kashmir yesterday pushing the death toll in the Valley to 58 in the month even as curfew and security restrictions continue to remain in place in the Valley. So far there have been 933 pellet cases. On Monday seven civilians including 4 women were hit by pellets in Anantnag district. There are no signs of clashes and protests getting abetting in the Valley.
