Title: Need to initiate immediate action for revival of Parvathy Mills in Kollam, Kerala.

SHRI N.K. PREMACHANDRAN (KOLLAM): Sir, Parvathy Mills Kollam, Kerala was one of the mills identified for revival under the sanctioned rehabilitation scheme of BIFR. The NTC has modernized other four mills in Kerala and are now running on profit. Parvathy mills is having all infrastructure for revival with minimum cost. Sufficient land is available for accommodating a new mill with open end spinning. The existing power connection, the factory licence etc which have been kept in suspense can be revived without any additional expense. The employees remaining in the roll can be utilized for the required man power. A concrete proposal for comprehensive modernization of it is pending with the Ministry. It can be modernized with minimum investment and it is possible to achieve good profit.

Hence I urge upon the Government of India to initiate immediate action for revival of Parvathy Mills.
