title: Regarding restoring the Mother tongue as one of the subjects in class 10th exam.

SHRI B. SRIRAMULU: As per the notification of 2014, passing of 10<sup>th</sup> Class having mother tongue as one of the subjects was mandatory for multitasking staff. However, the 2015 notification exempted that criteria for allowing candidates from other States to be appointed in Karnataka. This is causing resentment among the people of my constituency where many educated but unemployed youth are struggling to find employment and also when they see jobs being taken away by people from other States. They are becoming frustrated. They should get a fair chance in terms of getting employment.

In this regard, I would like to mention that the new notification allows the youth from other States to get employment outside their home State. However, the Government of Jharkhand has insisted and made it mandatory that people who have passed 10<sup>th</sup> Class from the State must have the mother tongue as a subject.

I would like urge upon the Government to take note of this demand of the people and restore the 2014 criteria having the mother tongue as one of the subjects in the 10<sup>th</sup> Class for recruitment for multitasking staff.
