Title: Felicitation to Prof. Amartya Sen on his winning 1998 Nobel Prize for economics.

MR. SPEAKER: Hon. Members are aware that a son of India, Prof. Amartya Sen, outstanding economist and thinker has been awarded the 1998 Nobel Prize for Economics for his path breaking work in the field of welfare and development economics.
