## COMMITTEE ON PRIVATE MEMBERS' BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS

## TWENTY-FIRST REPORT

(SECOND LOK SABHA)

- I, the Chairman of the Committee on Private Members' Bills and Resolutions having been authorised by the Committee, present on their behalf, this their Twenty-first Report.
- 2. The Committee met on the 22nd April, 1958 to consider allotment of time to the Resolutions set down in the List of Business for Friday, the 25th April, 1958.
- 3. The Members whose Resolutions had been included in the List of Business for the 25th April, 1958 and the representatives of the Ministries concerned had been invited to present their views on these Resolutions before the Committee.
