TWENTY-FIFTH REPORT

(SECOND LOK SABHA)

- I, the Chairman of the Committee on Private Members' Bills and Resolutions having been authorised by the Committee, present on their behalf, this their Twenty-fifth Report.
- 2. The Committee met on the 26th August, 1958 to consider allotment of time to the Resolutions set down in the List of Business for Saturday, the 30th August, 1958.
