COMMITTEE ON PRIVATE MEMBERS' BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS

TWENTY-EIGHTH REPORT

(SECOND LOK SABHA)

I, the Chairman of the Committee on Private Members' Bills and Resolutions having been authorised by the Committee, present on their behalf, this their Twenty-eighth Report.

2. The Committee met on the 23rd September, 1958 to consider allotment of time to the Resolutions set down in the List of Business for Saturday, the 27th September, 1958.

3. The Members whose resolutions had been included in the List of Business for the 27th September, 1958 and the representatives of the Ministries concerned had been invited to present their views on the resolutions before the Committee.
