*FIFTY-FOURTH REPORT

(SECOND LOK SABHA)

On behalf of the Committee on Private Members' Bills and Resolutions, I, having been authorised by the Committee, present on their behalf, this their Fifty-fourth Report.

- 2. The Committee met on the 14th December, 1959 to consider allotment of time to the Resolutions set down in the List of Business for Friday, the 18th December, 1959.
