COMMITTEE ON PRIVATE MEMBERS' BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS

*FORTY-NINTH REPORT

(SECOND LOK SABHA)

On behalf of the Committee on Private Members' Bills and Resolutions, I, having been authorised by the Committee, present on their behalf, this their Forty-ninth Report.

- 2. The Committee met on the 31st August, 1959 to consider allotment of time to the Resolutions set down in the List of Business for Friday, the 4th September, 1959.
- 3. The Members whose resolutions had been included in the List of Business for the 4th September, 1959 had been invited to present their views on the resolutions before the Committee. Sarvashri Hem Raj, Prakash Vir Shastri and Inder J. Malhotra attended the sitting.
- 4. The Committee, after hearing the members and considering all aspects with respect to each resolution, recommend the following time-table: -
 - (1) Resolution regarding Reference of Out of total time of 2 hours Tibet issue to the U.N.O. allotted to this Resolution. 28 minutes were taken up on the 21st August, 1959. The balance of I hour and 32 minutes would be available on the 4th September, 1959.
 - (2) Resolution regarding Session of Lok Sabha at Hyderabad or Bangalore.
