COMMITTEE ON PRIVATE MEMBERS' BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS

TWENTY-THIRD REPORT

(SECOND LOK SABHA)

- I, the Chairman of the Committee on Private Members' Bills and Resolutions having been authorised by the Committee, present on their behalf, this their Twenty-third Report.
- 2. The Committee met on the 12th August, 1958 to consider allotment of time to the Resolutions set down in the List of Business for Saturday, the 16th August, 1958.
- 3. The Members whose resolutions had been included in List of Business for the 16th August, 1958 and the representatives of the Ministries concerned had been invited to present their views on the resolutions before the Committee. Sarvashri C. R. Narasimhan, Hirendra Nath Mukerjee and Shrimati Renuka also the representatives of the Ministries of Commerce and Industry, External Affairs, Transport and Communications, Defence Finance attended the sitting.
