COMMITTEE ON PRIVATE MEMBERS' BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS

FIFTEENTH REPORT

(SECOND LOK SABHA)

- I, the Chairman of the Committee on Private Members' Bills and Resolutions having been authorised by the Committee, present on their behalf, this their Fifteenth Report.
- 2. The Committee met on the 25th February, 1958 to consider allotment of time to the Resolutions set down in the List of Business for Friday, the 28th February, 1958.
- 3. The Members whose Resolutions had been included in the List of Business for the 28th February, 1958 and the representatives of the Ministries concerned had been invited to present their views on these Resolutions before the Committee. Sarvashri Bhakt Darshan and Rameshwar Tantia and the representatives of the Ministries of Finance, Home Affairs and External Affairs attended the sitting.
- 4. The Committee after hearing the representatives of the Ministries concerned with the Resolutions and considering all aspects with respect to the Resolutions in the List of Business for the 28th February, 1958, recommend the following time-table:—
- (1) Resolution regarding Commission to Out of the total time of $2\frac{1}{2}$ hours allotted to inquire into indiscipline among students. this resolution, 54 minutes were taken up on the 14th February, 1958. The balance of 1 hour and 36 minutes would be available on the 28th February, 1958.
- (2) Resolution regarding Statutory limits on Government's power of borrowing.
