THIRTY-FIRST REPORT

I, the Chairman of the Committee on Private Members' Bills and Resolutions, having been authorised by the Committee to present the Report on their behalf, present this Thirty-first Report.

2. The Committee met on 9 April, 1979 for—

- I. Classification and allocation of time for discussion of Bills (*vide* Appendix) under clauses (b) and (c) of Rule 294(1) of the Rules of Procedure.
- II. Allocation of time under Rule 294(1) (e) of the Rules of Procedure to the Resolutions at items Nos. 3, 4 and 5 set down in the List of Business for Thursday, 12 April, 1979.
- III. Reconsideration of the classification of the Reservation of (certain categories of) cloth to Handlooms Bill, 1978 by Shri P. Rajagopal Naidu.

Classification and allocation of time to Bills

3. After considering all aspects of the Bills, the Committee recommend that all the Bills referred to in the Appendix be placed in category 'B'. The Committee recommend allocation of time for each of the Bills as shown in column 5 of the Appendix.

Allocation of time to Resolutions

4. The Committee recommend the allocation of time as follows:

Reconsideration of classification of a Bill

5. The Committee then considered the request of Shri P. Rajagopal Naidu to reconsider their earlier decision (*vide* Fifteenth Report) and place his Bill, namely, the Reservation of (certain categories of) Cloth to Handlooms Bill, 1978 in category 'A'.

6. The Committee did not see any justification for altering the original categorisation of the Bill.

Recommendations

7. The Committee recommend that—

- (i) the classification and allocation of time to Bills by the Committee, as shown in Appendix, be agreed to by the House; and
- (ii) the allocation of time to resolutions, as shown in paragraph 4 above, be agreed to by the House.
