## (Seventh Lok Sabha)

### NINETEENTH REPORT

- I, the Chairman of the Committee on Private Members' Bills and Resolutions, having been authorised by the Committee to present the Report on their behalf, present this Nineteenth Report.
  - 2. The Committee met on 23 March, 1981 for-
    - I. Allocation of time under Rule 294(1)(e) of the Rules of Procedure to the Resolutions at item Nos. 2 and 3 set down in the List of Business for Friday, 27 March, 1981.
    - II. Further examination of the Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 1981 (Amendment of article 79, etc.) by Shri Balasaheb Vikhe Patil under Rule 294(1)(a) of the Rules of Procedure.

### Allocation of time to Resolutions

- 3. The Committee recommend the allocation of time as follows:—
  - (1) Resolution regarding development of hilly regions. 2 hours
  - (2) Resolution regarding instruction of students through mother tongue. 2 hours

Further examination of the Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 1981 (Amendment of article 79, etc.) by Shri Balasaheb Vikhe Patil

- 4. The Member-in-charge of the Bill was invited to attend the sitting to present before the Committee his views on the Bill. Shri Balasaheb Vikhe Patil attended the sitting.
- 5. The Bill seeks to amend the Constitution with a view to abolish the Council of States and the Legislative Councils in the States.
- 6. After hearing the views of Shri Balasaheb Vikhe Patil and perusing the opinion furnished by the Ministry of Law, Justice and Company Affairs, the Committee postponed further consideration of the Bill.

### Recommendations

7. The Committee recommend that the allocation of time to resolutions, as shown in paragraph 3 above, be agreed to by the House.
