# COMMITTEE ON PRIVATE MEMBERS BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS 

## FORTY-EIGHTH REROAT

(Third Lok Sinku)
I, the Chairman of the Committee on Private Members Bills and Rexolutions having been authorised by the Committee, present on thetr befarf thits their Forty-ighth Report.
2. The Committee met on the 21nt September, 1964 for-
(1) Classification and allocation of time for dacussion of the Bills (vide Appendix).

- (1i) Examination of the Conatitution (Amendment) Bill, 1964 (Hmenchenat of the Seventh. Schedfle) by Shri Balkrishna Wasnik under Rule 294 (1) (a) of the Rulem of Procedure.
(III) Allocation of time for consideration of amendments made by Rajya Sabha to the Salaries and Allowances of Members of Parliament (Amendment) Bill, 1964.


## Classification and Allocation of time to bills

3. The Members concerned had been invited to prevent before the Committee their views on their Bills. Sarvashri Hari Vishnu Kamath, S. N. Chaturvedi, Panna Lal Barupal, V. C. Parathar, Nihar Ranjan Laskar and Krishnapal Singh attended the sitting.
4. After convidering all aspects of the Bills, the Committee placed all the Bills in category 'B' and allotted time for each of the Bills as shown in column 5 of Appendix.

## Examination of the Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 1964 (Amerdment of the Seventh Schedule) by Shri Balkrishna Wasnik

5. The Bill sought to make "intoxicating liquors" a Concurrent subject.

After hearing the representative of the Ministry of Home Affairs and considering all aspects of the matter, the Committee recommended that the Member might bepermitted to move for leave to introduce the Bill.

## Allocation of time for consideration of amendments made by Rajya Sabha to the salaries and allowances of Members of Parliament (Amendment) Bill, 1964

6. Shri Raghunath Singh, the Member incharge of the Bill, had been invited topresent before the Committee his views on the amendments made by Rajya Sabha to . the Bill and he attended the sitting.

After considering all aspects of the Bill, the Committee alloted 45 minutes for the discussion of the amendments made by Rajya Sabha to the Salaries and Allowances of Members of Parliament (Amendment) Bill, 1964 (Amendment of sections 3 and 5), as paseed by Lok Sabha.
