13 of their 231st Report (Seventh Lok Sabha) had recommended as under:

The Committee have given a careful thought to the proposal made by the Controller General of Accounts, Ministry of Finance (Department of Expenditure) for discontinuance of the practice of inclusion of Financial Review-cum-Commercial Accounts of the Canteen Stores Department in the Civil Appropriation Accounts. They see force in the argument advanced by the Controller General of Accounts that there is hardly any point in including the Financial Review-cum-Commercial counts of the Canteen Stores Department as an Appendix to the Civil Appropriation Accounts when this is not being done in respect of 41 other departmentally run undertakings, some of which are major organisations of Government, both in respect of outlay and realm of activities compared to the Canteen Stores Department. The Committee also take note of the assurance of the Controller General of Accounts that discontinuance the practice of inclusion of Financial Review-cum-Commercial Accounts of the Canteen Stores Department will not in any way change the existing practice regarding the preparation of the Financial Review-cum-Commercial proforma accounts of the Canteen Stores Department.
- 13. In view of the foregoing, the Committee agree to the proposal made by the Controller General of Accounts for discontinuance of the practice of inclusion of Financial Review-cum-Commercial Accounts of the Canteen Stores Department from the Civil Appropriation Accounts for 1983-84 and onwards."
