(a) : 'Rural Roads' is a State subject and Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) is a one-time special intervention to provide rural connectivity, by way of a single all-weather road, to the eligible unconnected habitations in the core network. Under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) details of funds released during the last three years and the current year, State-wise as per **Annexure**.
