- (a) the salient features of the Bharatmala project recently launched by the Government;
- (b) the details of funds likely to be sanctioned for this project along with the details of the number of States likely to be covered initially under this project across the country, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the States having international boundaries have also been included under this project, if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the National Highways which were sanctioned earlier have also been included under this project, along with the total length of roads/highways likely to be constructed under this project, State/UT-wise; and
- (e) the time by which this project is likely to be completed?

(a) The Cabinet has accorded approval to the investment proposal for the programme Bharatmala Pariyojana(BMP) Phase I on 24.10.2017 for 34,800 km and outlay of Rs 5,35,000 crore. There are six components under this approved programme:

i.	Economic Corridors	9,000 km
ii.	Inter corridors and Feeder Roads	6,000 km
iii.	National Corridors Efficiency Improvement	5,000 km
iv.	Border and International Connectivity Roads	2,000 km
v.	Coastal and Port Connectivity Roads	2,000 km
vi.	Expressways	800 km
	Total:	24,800 km
	Balance works under NHDP	10,000 km
	Total for Phase I	34,800 km

The above is to be implemented over a period of five years i.e. 2017-18 to 2021-22 with approved outlay of Rs.5,35,000 Crore.

(b) The total approved outlay for Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase I is Rs 5,35,000 crore spread over a five-year period i.e. 2017-18 to 2021-22. The year wise breakup of the proposed expenditure is as follows:

The programme on implementation shall connect 550 Districts in the country through NH linkages. Currently, around 300 Districts have NH linkages.

(c) Yes Madam. Border and International Connectivity Roads is one of the approved components of the Bharatmala programme. Around 2,000 kms are being taken up under this category in Phase-I of Bharatmala. List of identified projects in this category is placed at Annexure.

(d) Yes Madam. Balance National Highway (NH) works under the National Highways Development Project (NHDP) of around 10,000 km is included in Phase I of Bharatmala Pariyojana. The projects are under various stages of Detail Project Report (DPR) preparation.

(e) Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase I is to be implemented over a period of five years i.e. 2017-18 to 2021-22.
