### \*63. SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV:

Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the funds under the Member of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme (MPLADS) can be used for medical relief and agriculture welfare scheme;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the process proposed to be adopted for the purpose;
- (c) whether funds under MPLADS can also be utilized for treatment of poor people in Government or recognized hospitals;
- (d) whether there is any proposal to amend the guidelines/policy of MPLADS in public interest; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Individual benefits and movable & non-durable assets (certain exemptions excepted) are generally not allowed under the scheme.
