USE OF RENEWABLE ENERGY

2658. SHRI PRALHAD JOSHI:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the manner in which the Railways, the largest consumer of power in the country is tapping renewable sources of energy to cut its electricity bill; and
- (b) the quantum of money saved by the Railways as a result of producing and consuming renewable energy in its vast network during the last two financial years and the current year?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

- (a) Indian Railways is tapping renewable energy through developer mode on Railways/private land and on roof top of Railway buildings to cut its electricity bills.
- (b) The amount of savings from renewable energy depends upon the market forces. Annualized savings for the year 2015-16 is about ₹ 20 crore, for the year 2016-17 about ₹ 30 crore and for the current year (upto November 2017) is about ₹ 28 crore.
