Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government provides funds to various State Governments for purchasing buses under the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM);
- (b) if so, the amount of funds allocated and released in this regard during each of the last three years;
- (c) whether the State Governments have utilized the allocated funds properly; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) Government of India provided financial assistance for procurement of buses under Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM) in the form of Additional Central Assistance (ACA) to various State Governments upto 31.03.2015. Further, funding was continued under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) upto 31.03.2017. During the last three years an amount of Rs.1236.94 crore was released to 18 States. Details of funds allocated, released and utilized are at Annexure-I.
