**TARGETS FOR CONSTRUCTION**

- (a) the achievements of the Ministry during the last three years;
- (b) whether the Ministry has fallen short of its targets and if so, the details thereof along with the areas where it has excelled;
- (c) the targets set for the coming three years and the roadmap to achieve the same; and
- (d) the details of core areas the Ministry proposes to focus during the coming years?

- (a) Ministry has awarded projects of length 34,018 km and constructed 18,702 km of National Highways during the last three financial years.
- (b) Ministry has fallen short of targets overall during the last financial year mainly due to problem of land acquisition, utility shifting, non-availability of Soil/Aggregates, Poor performance of contractors, Environment/ Forest/Wildlife Clearance, ROB & RUB issue with Railways, Public agitation for additional facilities.
- (c) to (d) Targets are finalized on year to year basis. Bharatmala, Sagarmala, & Chardham are some of the core identified schemes where ministry proposes to focus in the coming years.
