**Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of schemes launched by the Government in various States/UTs of the country for development and promotion of tourism along with the details of the schemes on which work has been done by the Government to encourage and Promote Government and Non-Governmental Organization (NGOs) during the last three years and the current year;**
- (b) whether these schemes have been reviewed and if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) the funds allocated as financial assistance to various States/UTs for development and promotion of tourism during the last three years, State/UT-wise including Madhya Pradesh, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Maharashtra and particularly Allahabad in Uttar Pradesh;**
- (d) whether the Government has made any efforts to construct economical hotels for the low budget tourists in the country; and**
- (e) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise including Maharashtra and the other steps taken/being taken by the Government for the development and promotion of tourism in the country?**

**(a) to (c): The major schemes of the Ministry of Tourism for development and promotion of tourism in the country are:**

- 1) Integrated Development of Theme Based Tourist Circuits – Swadesh Darshan**
- 2) National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)**
- 3) Assistance to Central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development**
- 4) Domestic Promotion and Publicity including Hospitality (DPPH)**
- 5) Restructured Scheme of Overseas Promotion & Publicity Including Market Development Assistance (MDA)**

**The objective of the schemes of Swadesh Darshan, PRASHAD and Assistance to Central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development is to develop tourism related infrastructure in different States/Union Territory Administrations in the country. The list of the projects sanctioned under the above mentioned three schemes in various States/UTs including Madhya Pradesh, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh during the last three years and current year is given at Annexure.**

**The Ministry of Tourism does not have specific scheme to provide financial assistance to Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs). However, Ministry of Tourism provides financial assistance to organizers of events that have the potential for promoting tourism to and/or within the country. The proposals are sanctioned on the basis of the eligibility conditions mentioned in the guidelines and information regarding the status of the organizers as to whether they are Registered Societies, Private Limited Companies, Non-Governmental Organisations etc. is not specifically solicited.**

**Ministry of Tourism has reviewed the existing major schemes to be continued beyond 12<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan.**

**(d) and (e): The construction of hotels is primarily a private sector activity. The Ministry of Tourism classifies operational hotels and gives project approvals to different categories of hotels at project implementation stage which are voluntary schemes.**

**The steps taken to promote and develop different tourism products include the following:**

- i) Launching the Swadesh Darshan Scheme for integrated development of theme based tourist circuits.**
- ii) Launching the National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD) Scheme to beautify and improve amenities and infrastructure at pilgrimage sites.**
- iii) Launching e-Visa.**
- iv) Production of publicity and promotional material.**
- v) Launching of Incredible India 2.0 Campaign marking a shift from generic promotions to market specific promotional plans.**
- vi) Developing and promoting 'Niche Tourism' products.**
- vii) Generating sufficient manpower to meet the requirements of the tourism and hospitality industry.**
- viii) Launching 24x7 toll free Multi-Lingual Tourist Helpline.**
- ix) Launching of New Incredible India Website.**
