- (a): The State/UT wise details of alleged cases of rape received in the National Commission for Women during the last three years and the current year up to 23.7.2018 is annexed (Annexure).

Keeping in view the large number of complaints received and the quantum of correspondence with the State/UTs, the data being voluminous, the case files thereof are available with the commission. However, the NCW takes all complaints received by it with the respective State/UTs authorities and pursues the matter with them till it is taken to its logical conclusion.
- (c): As per NCW, no such funds have been released for such activities to States/UTs.
- (d): No Madam. No separate suggestions have been sent by the National Commission for Women to any State on the subject during last two years.
