Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has identified any medical colleges in the country for upgradation under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise including Gujarat and Haryana;
- (b) the funds allocated/targets achieved for the PMSSY during the last three years and the current year, State/ UT-wise;
- (c) the funds earmarked/utilised for opening of New AIIMS in the country and current status of work on these new AIIMS, State/UT-wise including Gujarat and Haryana; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government to complete the said projects?

(a) & (b): Yes. Government of India has approved up-gradation of 73 Government Medical Colleges/Institutes in different phases under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY).

Details are attached as Annexure-I.

(c): Details of new AIIMS being set up under PMSSY are attached as Annexure-II.

(d) MoHFW has taken all possible steps to expedite completion of the remaining works at six AIIMS. Apart from construction, procurement and recruitment of staff has also been expedited to achieve full functionality of six AIIMS by December 2018.

Apart from the above, the 9 new AIIMS have been approved by the Cabinet. Further, 6 AIIMS are also in various stages of approval. The Details are given in Annexure-II.
