RURAL DEVELOPMENT SCHEMES

1478. SHRI NANDI YELLAIAH:

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) the various schemes introduced by the Union Government for rural development at present;
- (b) the details of rural development schemes being implemented in the districts falling under Mahbubnagar Parliamentary Constituency;
- (c) the number of beneficiaries, males and females benefited under such schemes during the years 2014-15, 2015- 16 and 2016-17 through banking, rural banking postal services and by- hand; and
- (d) the quantum of funds released for the above purpose for the districts falling under Mahbubnagar Parliamentary Constituency for the year 2014-15, 2015- 16 and 2016-17?

(a) & (b) : The Ministry of Rural Development, inter-alia, is implementing Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA), Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM), Deen Dayal Upadhyay – Gramin Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana – Gramin (PMAY-G), Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP) and Shyama Prasad Mukerjee Rurban Mission (SPMRM) to bring about overall improvement in the quality of life of the people in rural areas including Mahbubnagar through employment generation, strengthening of livelihood opportunities, promoting self-employment, skilling of rural youths, provision of social assistance and other basic amenities.

(c) : The details of number of beneficiaries, males and females benefited under major rural development programmes during 2014-15 to 2016-17 are given at **Annexure-I**.

(d) : Ministry of Rural Development releases funds to the states. Further releases to district and sub district levels are made by the State Government. Funds released to the state of Telangana under major rural development programmes during 2014-15 to 2016-17 are given at **Annexure-II**.
