(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether Defence Acquisition Council (DAC) has cleared the proposal to set up such organisation;

(d) if so, the time by which the organisation is likely to take shape; and

(e) the benefits likely to be derived after setting up this organisation and the extent to which armed forces are likely to get arms and ammunition in time?
