CHAURÍDÁRÍ ACT EXTENSION BILL.

The Hon'ble Mr. Stephen moved that the Hon'ble Mr. Strachey be added to the Select Committee on the Bill to authorise the extension of the Chaukídárí Act (XX of 1856) to places where there is no Jamadár of Police.

The Motion was put and agreed to.

LAND IMPROVEMENT BILL.

The Hon'ble Mr. Stermen moved with the permission of the President, on behalf of the Hon'ble Mr. Strachey, that His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor of the Panjáb be added to the Select Committee on the Bill to consolidate and amend the law relating to advances of money by the Government for the improvement of land.

The Motion was put and agreed to.
