The Council met in the Council Chamber of the Council House at Half Past Six of the Clock, the Honourable the President in the Chair.

BILLS PASSED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY LAID ON THE TABLE.

SECRETARY OF THE COUNCIL: Sir, in pursuance of rule 25 of the Indian Legislative Rules, I lay on the table copies of the following Bills which were passed by the Legislative Assembly at its meetings held on the 20th and 21st April, 1936, namely:

- A Bill to remove certain doubts and to establish the validity of certain proceedings in High Courts of Judicature in British India.
- A Bill further to amend the Indian Tariff Act, 1934, for certain purposes.
- A Bill to make special provision for the administration of the port of Cochin.
- A Bill further to amend the Factories Act, 1934, for a certain purpose.
- A Bill to amend the Indian Aircraft Act, 1934, for a certain purpose.
- A Bill further to amend the Indian Mines Act, 1923, for certain purposes.
- A Bill further to amend the Indian Lac Cess Act, 1930, for certain purposes.

STATEMENT OF BUSINESS.

THE HONOURABLE THE PRESIDENT: I have just gone through the five Bills which you propose the Council may discuss on Thursday and I quite agree with you that they are non-contentious Bills and I do not think other Honourable Members will have any objection to their being taken up on Thursday. The other two important Bills may, as proposed by you, be taken up on Friday. I take it that Honourable Members have no objection.

(No Honourable Member objected.)

I am also agreeable to adjourn the Council till tomorrow evening at 6-30 P.M.

THE HONOURABLE KUNWAR SIR JAGDISH PRASAD: Will it be 6 or 6-30 P.M., Sir?

THE HONOURABLE THE PRESIDENT: What do you suggest? I think it will be cooler at 6-30 P.M

THE HONOURABLE KUNWAR SIR JAGDISH PRASAD: We can meet at 6-30 p.m., Sir.

THE HONOURABLE THE PRESIDENT; The Council will now adjourn till 6-30 P.M. tomorrow.

The Council then adjourned till Half Past Six of the Clock on Wednesday, the 22nd April, 1936.
