

SHRI DEVENDRA PRASAD YADAV (Jhanjharpur): Mr. Speaker, Sir, today is 150th Anniversary of our First War of Independence. ...(Interruptions)

SHRI BASU DEB ACHARIA (Bankura): Mr. Speaker, Sir, today is the 150th Anniversary of our great revolution, First War of Independence. In order to honour and respect the martyrs who fought against the British imperialism and laid down their lives for the freedom of our country, we request you, if you can, to adjourn the House. ...(Interruptions)

PROF. VIJARY KUMAR MALHOTRA (South Delhi): Mr. Speaker, Sir, I agree with him. To honour the 150th Anniversary of First War of Independence the House should be adjourned today. ...(Interruptions)

[English]

THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI PRIYA RANJAN DASMUNSI): Sir, we do not have any objection. ...(Interruptions)

MR. SPEAKER: We are united on this issue.

SHRI DEVENDRA PRASAD YADAV: Sir to express our respect towards those freedom fighters, the proceeding of the House should be withheld and the statement about Delhi, that should be ...(Interruptions)

MR. SPEAKER: You are sharing my agony.

SHRI PRIYA RANJAN DASMUNSI: Sir, yesterday a concern against the Delhi issue was raised by the hon. Members. The Chief Minister of Delhi has publicly apologized, called a Press Conference and made a healthy statement. We all share with the concern expressed by the hon. Members. ...(Interruptions)

PROF. VIJAY KUMAR MALHOTRA: Mr. Speaker, Sir, this matter should not be taken today that what statement was made by whom. ...(Interruptions)

MR. SPEAKER: When we are going to adjourn the House on a united basis, let us not raise controversial matters now.

Well, I am your servant. Now, the House stands adjourned to meet again on Monday, the 14th May, 2007 at 11 a.m.
