MR. SPEAKER: Newspapers are not required, question is needed. Please follow the advice. You please sit down.

Do not advise me please. Malhotraji, you may please speak.

Democracy is being subverted there. The person who has been sworn as Chief Minister over there is not having support of majority and is being tried for a murder.

Mr. Speaker, Sir, the democracy has been murdered over there, and there has been brazen violation of democracy there. The way....*
