(a) whether Government have reviewed the performance of State Pollution Control Boards for the last three years;

(b) if so, details thereof, State-wise and year-wise;

(c) the major deficiencies in the working and performance of State Pollution Control Boards, State-wise;

(d) the steps taken/proposed to be taken to make them more efficient, capable, properly equipped and strengthen; and

(e) the additional fund proposed for this purpose during the Ninth Plan, State-wise break-up?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EN-VIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRI BABU LAL MARANDI): (a) to (c) The State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs) are under the administrative control of respective State Governments. The performance of State Pollution Control Boards are reviewed by the concerned State Governments. However, based on interaction with State Pollution Control Boards by the Central Pollution Control Board on national programmes, the deficiencies that have been noticed relate to inadequate infrastructure and, lack of resources.

(d) The steps taken/proposed to be taken for strengthening of SPCBs include the following:

- (i) Increasing water cess rate to augment their financial resources;
- (ii) Strengthening of SPCBs in terms of laboratory facilities;
- (iii) Providing training to the officials of SPCBs on different aspects relating to prevention and control of pollution;
- (iv) Financial assistance for specific programmes for abatement of pollution.
- (v) Providing of monitoring equipment and analytical instruments to SPCBs under the capacity building project of the World Bank.

(e) No additional funds has been proposed in the 9th Five Year Plan.
