Rehabilitation of Asian Lions in Kuno Palpur Sanctuary

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Union Government had sanctioned

6.63 crore to the Government of Madhya Pradesh during 1996-97 for the rehabilitation of asian lions in Kuno Palpur sanctuary;

(b) if so, the amount released so far;

(c) the reasons for not releasing the entire amount;

(d) whether the partially released amount would be sufficient to meet the required job; and

(e) if not, the time by which the balance amount is likely to be released to the State Government?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRI BABU LAL MARANDI):

(a) No, Sir. However, an amount of Rs. 6.63 crores has been sanctioned to the Government of Madhya Pradesh during 1996-97 for the relocation of 663 tribal families outside Kuno Palpur Sanctuary. This is part of a programme to introduce lions in the Sanctuary.

(b) An amount of Rs. 1.62 crore so far has been released in three instalments.

(c) The funds have been released in accordance with budgetary allocation.

(d) No, Sir.

(e) The balance amount is proposed to be given in subsequent instalments during IX Plan period.
