THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES): (a) to (c) During the recent visit of Raksha Mantri to France from January 11-14, 1999 both countries agreed that cooperation between the armed forces of the two countries will be based upon jointly agreed programmes including joint exercises. No dates have been finalised as yet for joint exercises between the navies of the two countries.

**Foreign Investment in F.P.I.**

1300. SHRI DATTA MEGHE: Will the Minister of FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government have started any new programme to invite foreign investment in Food Processing Industry; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING AND MINISTER OF FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI PRAMOD MAHAJAN): (a) and (b) The Government has laid down a liberal policy framework for promotion of foreign investment in food processing sector. Most of the items have been delicensed and are eligible for automatic foreign investment upto 51% of equity. Even for foreign investment beyond 51%, the Foreign Investment Promotion Board considers those cases liberally.

To promote foreign investment in food processing industries, the Ministry of Food Processing Industries provides financial assistance under its Plan schemes for preparation of promotional literature, supports participation in international events such as Promotional Missions, Trade Fairs etc. and undertakes a variety of other measures to attract investment.
