Appointment of Out-door Booking Agency

1356. SHRI RAMSHETH THAKUR: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) the parameter/guidelines fixed for appointment of outdoor air booking agents for booking of parcel/luggage and imported vehicles under liberalisation schemes;

(b) whether according to these parameters the Government contemplate to appoint such outdoor booking agents at Raigarh near Mumbai which has been declared an industrial district by the State Government;

(c) if so, the time by which Government contemplate to appoint such agents; and

(d) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION AND MINISTER OF TOURISM (SHRI ANANTH KUMAR): (a) The guidelines for appointment of cargo agents are (a) Availability of suitable warehouse. (b) Requisite number of weighing scales. (c) Own transport arrangement for the movement of cargo booked to an airport and for picking-up the same from shipper warehouses. (d) Telephone connectivity. (e) Qualified/trained staff. (f) Two staff trained in handling of Dangerous Goods.

(b) to (d) No such proposal is under consideration. No request or application has been received for appointment of booking agency at Raigarh near Mumbai.

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES): (a) and (b) No war Museum has been set up at the National level.

Flight on Jabalpur-Raipur Sector

1358. DR. LAXMINARAYAN PANDEY: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether the State Government have requested to start air service from Raipur to Jabalpur; and

(b) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto?

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION AND MINISTER OF TOURISM (SHRI ANANTH KUMAR): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Government has laid down route dispersal guidelines with a view to achieve better regulation of air transport services taking into account the need for air transport services of different regions of the country. It is, however, up to the airlines to provide air services to specific places including Jabalpur depending upon the traffic demand and commercial viability subject to compliance of route dispersal guidelines issued by Government.

Revision of Fee by D.G., Doordarshan

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MUKHTAR NAQVI): (a) and (b) As reported by Prasar Bharati, fees of casual artists engaged by Doordarshan to meet programme exigencies were revised in September, 1998. The fees ranges from Rs. 150/- to Rs. 400/- per assignment.

(c) Yes, Sir.

(d) As reported by Prasar Bharati, the fee of casual stenographers engaged in news rooms at regional units of different Doordarshan Kendras was fixed at Rs. 200/ per day in October, 1997 without relating it to any regular scale of pay.
