

Studio Facilities in Doordarshan Centres in U.P.

1377. SHRI ASHOK PRADHAN: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

(a) whether studio facilities have been provided in all the Doordarshan Centres set up in Uttar Pradesh, particularly in Adivasi area;

(b) if so, the details thereof, location-wise;

(c) the details of the Doordarshan Centres where such facilities have not been provided so far, location-wise; and

(d) the time by which these facilities are likely to be provided there?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MUKHTAR NAQVI): (a) to (c) Whereas 106 TV transmitters (HPTs-9, LPTs-68, VLPTs-28, transposers-3) including one LPT at Lakhimpur (in notified Adivasi district Kheri), are presently functioning in Uttar Pradesh. Studio facilities are available only at Lucknow, Bareilly, Gorakhpur, Mau, Allahabad & Varanasi. Location-wise details of 106 transmitters are given in the statement attached.

(d) Scheme for establishment of a Studio set-up at Mathura is presently under implementation. There is no approved scheme at present, for providing studio facilities at any other Kendra in U.P.

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES): (a) to (c) Post Graduate study opportunities in the Army Medical Corps (AMC) are available at Armed Forces Medical College, Pune, Research & Referral Hospital, Delhi Cantt, Command Hospital (Air Force), Bangalore and INHS Asvini, Mumbai. All Post graduate seats in the Service Institutions are allotted strictly on the basis of merit-cum-choice following a Central PG entrance examination. Service officers who, on study leave, join Armed Forces Medical College, Pune, for super specialisation, however, do not have to go through a written test for admission. Army Medical Corps personnel have prior claim on the PG seats, depending upon the Service requirements. However, PG seats which are not availed of by the Service personnel are offered to other categories like Foreign sponsored candidates, ex-SSC officers and lastly, if any seats remain, they are offered to Civilian Doctors. Thus, the opportunities for the Post Graduate studies available to the Army Medical Corps personnel are not squandered.
