THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI DALIT EZHILMALAI): (a) and (b) A Project proposal for Government of Uttar Pradesh under the State Health Systems Development Project for World Bank assistance has been posed to the World Bank. Such State Projects are thereafter formulated through detailed discussions with the World Bank. Past experience shows that such proposals take 12 to 24 months to fructify, depending on the time taken on the design and formulation of the Project by the State. The State Authorities are kept fully involved in the discussion with representatives of the World Bank, at each stage. Hence it is not possible to comment on the final dimension of the Project at this juncture.

- (i) Paiur (ii) Nuepader (iii) Nampo (iv) Badem Talle (v) Adhajori (vi) Muthapada (vii) Birasel (viii) Taraboi (ix) Sarithanda (x) Roxy.
- (c) At present, 110 telephone exchanges have already been covered by optical fibre cables (OFC).
- (d) It is planned to provide OFC media to as many stations as possible by the year 2002. Due to topological conditions, some exchanges may be provided with other reliable transmission media and not by OFC.
